## Actuarial Society of Hong Kong High-level Proposal to Establish ASHK as a Statutory Body and Evening Discussion

As you may know, the Actuarial Society of Hong Kong has been undertaking an initiative to establish the ASHK as a Statutory Body for some years. The Council has taken a number of steps in order to make this to happen, but we are still far from achieving this goal. Recently the ASHK had engaged a new law firm to revisit the rationale for the statutory body project and to review the process of achieving statutory status for the ASHK.

1) Together with the new law firm, the Committee has prepared the attached presentation slides detailing a high-level proposal to turn ASHK into a Statutory Body. The purpose of these presentation slides are to keep our members informed of the proposed high-level changes to the ASHK; and to collect comments, if any, and reflect such comments in our preliminary discussion with regulatory bodies.
